Grease Trap Inspections Summary Report
May 31, 2015

FOG Control Program Update

In cooperation with HOVMSD Staff, we have put together a draft set of procedures to investigate non-commercial dischargers that are suspected of discharging FOG to the sanitary sewer. These dischargers could include facilities which already have grease traps or those that may be required to add a grease trap. A copy of the draft is included with this mailing.

The proposed procedures will be discussed at the June 9 Commission meeting. Of interest is the provision asking for periodic reporting from the Communities in regard to the results of their sanitary sewer maintenance and inspection programs. Each Community's input on the provision is encouraged.

Sites Requiring Grease Trap Installation

The following sites have been identified as requiring the installation of grease traps. Because of delays in plan approvals or retaining a plumber, we have extended the deadline for their trap installations until July 1, 2015. The Kaukauna Area School District sites may be a bit later due to scheduling constraints with summer vacation.

Summary of Site Visits & Correspondence:

Ponzies, Subway & Pizza Hut: On May 21, 2015 we visited Ponzies, Subway and pizza Hut to verify their grease trap installations. Each site has been assigned a cleaning frequency, which is shown on the attached table.

St Mary's Parish: The Parish is reviewing their options in regards to either removing their food service area or installing the grease trap. We have asked that they do something by July 1, 2015.

Site Visits and Correspondence (cont.):

Kaukauna Area School District: We will be meeting with a representative from the Kaukauna Area School District on June 4, 2015 to discuss the upcoming grease trap installation and maintenance of their existing traps. They wish to schedule the work outside of the normal school year and we will discuss options as to make that happen.

Bachelors Bar, Badger Quick Stop, Cake Anatomy and Verbeten's: During May, we contacted representatives from each listed establishment to get a revised timetable for their trap installation. Each indicated that the work would be done by July 1, 2015.
