

Village of Kimberly Grease Trap Inspections Summary Report April 30, 2015

FOG Control Program Update

In April, 2015, we met with a representative from the Village of Kimberly to discuss the progress of the FOG Control Program and identify basins in which the sanitary sewer laterals can be periodically observed to gauge the effectiveness of the existing grease traps.
