

Village of Little Chute Grease Trap Inspections Summary Report May 31, 2015

FOG Control Program Update

In cooperation with HOVMSD Staff, we have put together a draft set of procedures to investigate non-commercial dischargers that are suspected of discharging FOG to the sanitary sewer. These dischargers could include facilities which already have grease traps or those that may be required to add a grease trap. A copy of the draft is included with this mailing.

The proposed procedures will be discussed at the June 9 Commission meeting. Of interest is the provision asking for periodic reporting from the Communities in regard to the results of their sanitary sewer maintenance and inspection programs. Each Community's input on the provision is encouraged.

Summary of Site Visits & Correspondence

Taste of the Windy City: On May 21, 2015, we talked to Adam about his tardiness in cleaning the facility's grease trap. He cleaned it that day.

Down the Hill Bar: On May 26, 2015, we talked with Lisa about the progress of her grease trap installation. She has retained a plumber and says the trap will be installed by July 1, 2015.

The following have indicated that their grease traps will be installed by July 1, 2015. They were delayed by the need for plan approvals and/or misjudging the time frame needed to purchase and install a grease trap.
