

Village of Little Chute Grease Trap Inspections Summary Report June 30, 2015

FOG Control Program Update

We have prepared some samples of informational signs that can be placed in park shelters asking users not to put grease down the drains. The content and placement of the signs will be discussed at the July Commission meeting.

At the June Commission meeting, the guidelines for televising sanitary sewer lines and laterals were approved. Within the guidelines are requirements for submitting a summary report, by each community, of their manhole and sewer inspection findings every 6 months, as they relate to the observation and removal of grease in the sewer and manholes.

Each Community is asked to define the limits in which sewer televising may take place, in regards to televising private laterals from the main sewer and without the property owner's permission.

Summary of Site Visits & Correspondence

Bella Thai Cafe: On June 26, 2015, we talked to Jay about the grease trap cleaning schedule for the restaurant. He felt three months was too soon and did not clean the trap as we requested. We told him to clean the trap and we would evaluate his schedule based upon his contractor recommendations. Flush, Inc. cleaned the trap in mid-June and said that a 4 month schedule would be more appropriate. We adjusted their schedule accordingly.

El Jaripeo: On June 26, 2015, we talked with Antonio's father about submittal of documentation after they self-clean their trap. He said that he personally cleans the trap every Saturday and would fax over the documentation after each cleaning.
