

**Village of Kimberly  
Grease Trap Inspections Summary Report  
September 30, 2015**

**Summary of Site Visits and Correspondence:**

**Marcos Pizza:** We have informed Marcos Pizza of their obligations regarding installing a grease trap. To date, they have not made an appointment to allow us to inspect their facility. As soon as we confirm that they are open for business, we will stop in to perform our inspection.

**Caring For Kids:** The owner of Caring for Kids hired Peterson Plumbing to install their grease trap and the plans are currently being reviewed by the State.

**Little Caesars:** We have left numerous messages with the owner of Little Caesars and twice talked to the site manager about their past due cleaning. To date, we have not received any verification that the trap was cleaned. We will personally deliver a generic copy of the non-compliance letter to the store manager and owner. If we do not get a favorable response, we will recommend that the store be issued a non-compliance order.
