

# **Village of Kimberly Grease Trap Inspections Summary Report July 31, 2015**

## **Summary of Site Visits and Correspondence:**

**Holy Spirit School:** On August 11, 2015, we did receive an email from Joe Harvey of the Kimberly School District, indicating that they would not be utilizing the kitchen of the school in their early learning program. If that remains true, Holy Spirit Parish will not be required to install a grease trap. We did indicate that, should any food preparation or cleanup take place at the site, we would require a trap be installed.

**Marcos Pizza:** Marcos Pizza has not opened yet and may not for several more months. We will monitor the site and visit as soon as they do.

**Kimberly School District:** Both Maplewood and Westside schools were due for cleaning in August. This will be extended to later this fall because the traps were not utilized during summer break and would not require cleaning as normally scheduled.

**Hitters Sports Bar:** Hitters Sports bar installed their trap on or around August 1<sup>st</sup>. They will initially be placed on a three month cleaning schedule.
