HOVMSD FOG Control Program Update December 2015

Project Overview

A total of three sites still have not installed their grease traps. Dick's Drive In in Kaukauna was scheduled to have their trap installed in late December and Caring for Kids in Kimberly in early January. Both have hired Peterson Plumbing to do the work. The owner of Village Lanes in Little Chute does not return our calls and the owner is not available when we stop. As of December 31, 2015, no trap had been installed.

Overview by Community

Darboy Sanitary District: Two businesses will receive reminders letters. A total of seven sites require compliance visits.

Village of Combined Locks: Three reminder letters will be sent. No site visits are required.

Village of Kimberly: One site has not completed their grease trap installation. Caring for Kids has retained Peterson Plumbing, who indicated that the job would be done on or around January 7, 2016. A total of eight reminder letters will be sent and nine site visits will be scheduled.

Village of Little Chute: One site has not completed their grease trap installation. The owner of Village Lanes does not return our phone calls and is unavailable when we stop in. The number she gave us for Reader Plumbing is not answered and messages left on the company answering machine have not been returned. We will send her a reminder inviting her to the February Commission meeting to explain the lack of progress. If she ignores that letter, we will ask that the site be deemed non-compliant. Three reminder letters will be sent and two site visits will be conducted.

City of Kaukauna: Dick's Drive In had their trap installation scheduled for December 29, 2015. We have not yet verified the installation. A total of five sites require reminder letters and seven sites require site visits.
