HOVMSD FOG Control Program Update February 2016

Project Overview

At the February, 2016 Commission meeting, a revision of the parameters regarding grease trap installation requirements was discussed. A total of six businesses that had not been required to install grease traps, based upon the initial screening guidelines, were deemed to have food service facilities that would produce grease in quantities significant enough to warrant a grease trap, as defined in the State Plumbing Code. Two of the businesses are located in Little Chute and four in Kaukauna.

Overview by Community

Darboy Sanitary District: El Azteca no longer sends in the documentation from the cleaning of the exterior trap for their mini-mall. We check the trap monthly and find that it is cleaned on schedule and in good working order. We have contacted Pfefferle Management (the facility manager) about this and neither of us has been able to get the restaurant managers to submit the paperwork. Restaurant management has been somewhat fluid lately and there have been language barriers in trying to explain the documentation requirements of the program. At this point, we have chosen to continue with our monthly inspections with the hope that a more permanent manager is assigned to the site. Two sites will receive reminder letters and two sites require compliance visits.

Village of Combined Locks: No reminder letters are required and we are awaiting the scheduled cleaning of one past due user.

Village of Kimberly: Hitters Bar was sent a second notice to clean their grease trap and has not responded other than to indicate that the bar is for sale. We will stop by again and personally try to explain that the trap must be cleaned immediately. No reminder letters are required and three site visits will be scheduled.

Village of Little Chute: We have issued letters to The Heiting Place and Gentleman Jacks indicating that they will need to install grease traps by June, 2016. We did receive a response from The Heiting Place and have not heard back from Gentleman Jacks. One reminder letter will be sent and four site visits will be conducted.

City of Kaukauna: We have issued letters to ET's Dog Pound, Hillstreet Bar and Grill, Journey's Bar and K-Town Bar and Grill indicating that they will need to install grease traps at their facilities by June, 2016. So far, only ET's Dog Pound has responded. A total of two sites require reminder letters and four sites require site visits.
