The Fee A connection fee was established to recover costs of excess capacity from the Districts 1995 treatment plan expansion. The loan for the 1995 expansion was taken out for 20 years, and the Fee A connection fee was set to be collected for that same 20 year time period. The loan payments for the 1995 expansion ended in 2015, and the Fee A connections fees were also intended to end in 2015. Thus the fee rates listed in the SUO for Fee A only ran through 2015.
