HOVMSD FOG Control Program Update

April 2016

Project Overview

We received a call from the owner of the Heiting Place asking for some help in sourcing plumbers who do grease trap installations. He indicated that the plumbers he spoke with were really busy and either were charging him a premium for service in June or outright refused the work. We supplied him with the names of some plumbers who previously installed traps within the District. As is our policy, we did not specifically recommend any one contractor.

Because we have not heard from the other 5 businesses that are also under a June, 2016 deadline, we sent them a reminder letter, pointing out that the process of sourcing a contractor, obtaining plan approval and scheduling the installation, could take upwards of 90 days. Hopefully, this will take away the last second scrambling by the business owners to make the June deadline.

Overview by Community

Darboy Sanitary District: A total of 1 site requires a reminder letter and 2 will require site visits.

Village of Combined Locks: One site will require a reminder letter and no site visits are required.

Village of Kimberly: A total of 7 sites require reminder letters and 1 will require a site visit.

Village of Little Chute: We issued a letter to Gentleman Jacks reminding them that they need to have their grease trap installed by June, 2016. The Heiting Place called and is actively seeking a plumber for the project. A total of 3 reminder letters will be sent and no site visits are required.

City of Kaukauna: We issued letters to ET's Dog Pound, Hillstreet Bar and Grill, Journey's Bar and K-Town Bar and Grill reminding them of the June deadline to install their grease traps. A total of 4 sites require reminder letters and 1 site requires a site visit.
