Glen,

Just an update on where we are at.

We are still waiting on UW – Green Bay and Glacierland RC&D for an estimate on soil health sampling and testing. Glacierland's match money is starting to look less appealing as we cannot wait forever on this. I am working out an alternative work plan for these tasks for this reason.

USGS is also in discussions with EPA about additional funding. EPA is requesting a heavy metals study be added on to the project. Ken Ladwig has some reservations about this additional study detracting from the overall goal. If EPA will kick in funds for the existing project and covert he complete cost of the heavy metals study, things might work.

Dr. Arriaga and I met with upper level NRCS staff in Madison earlier this month. We used data from the existing project to get them to make adjustments to the gypsum application standard in WI. These changes should make it easier for farmers to get NRCS funding for gypsum applications for environmental benefit. Jimmy Bramblett, WI NRCS State Conservationist, asked his staff to look into adding funding for the project in the Fox.

There were a lot of moving pieces that needed to be sorted out and now more have been added. I am working closely with all these folks to get these things sorted out as soon as possible.
