HOVMSD FOG Control Program Update November 2016

Project Overview

Grease Trap Installation Update: During November, 2016, Journeys Bar and Hillstreet Bar and Grill installed their grease traps. They were the last two sites that were required to install grease traps under the FOG Control Program.

Overview by Community

Darboy Sanitary District: After receiving an invitation to attend the November, 2016 Darboy Sanitary District Commission meeting, Dickey's Barbeque Pit sent over their most current grease trap cleaning documentation and then closed the Darboy franchise. During an inspection of the first downstream manhole from Dickey's and the Pizza Ranch, the lateral line from Dickey's had a significant accumulation of grease on the sidewalls and the Pizza Ranch lateral was almost completely plugged. A contractor was retained by Pizza Ranch to clean their lateral and the next section of public sewer main. If another restaurant takes the space vacated by Dickey's, we will strongly encourage them to clean their lateral before opening. A total of 7 reminder letters are required and 4 site visits will be conducted.

Village of Combined Locks: Rico's Family Restaurant has become chronically late with their cleanings and document submittal. We did talk with Rico and he said that Kuettels is handling the cleaning and was supposed to have received permission from us to go to a less frequent cleaning schedule. We did not have that conversation with Kuettels, but will contact them for their input. Meanwhile, the trap is scheduled to be cleaned on December 8th. Two reminder letters will be sent and no site visits are required.

Village of Kimberly: Hitters Bar remains non-compliant and has not responded to our reminder letters. Kimberly Assisted Living changed their cleaning schedule without notice and a spot inspection found their trap to be full of grease. We are working with them and their cleaning contractor to get the trap cleaned and potentially modify their cleaning schedule. There are 3 reminder letters to send and 4 sites will require a site visit.

Village of Little Chute: There were no significant issues within the Village. There are 3 reminder letters to send and 2 site visits are required.

City of Kaukauna: Hillstreet Bar and Journey's Bar installed their traps in November. They were both assigned initial cleaning schedules of 6 months. We will review those schedules after the first cleaning. The owner of Hillstreet Bar and Grill has indicated that she will attend the December HOVMSD Commission meeting to discuss other sites, similar to hers, that have not been required to install grease traps. A total of 6 reminder letters will be sent and 1 site will require a site visit.
