HOVMSD FOG Control Program Update April 2017

Overview by Community

Darboy Sanitary District: Island Sushi remains on schedule to complete their grease trap installation by June.

A total of 2 reminder letters are required and 3 site visits will be conducted.

Village of Combined Locks: There were no significant issues in Combined Locks during April, 2017.

One reminder letter will be sent and 2 site visits are required.

Village of Kimberly: Management of Marcos Pizza called to say that they have closed the Kimberly store and put the site up for lease.

There are 2 reminder letters to send and 3 sites will require site visits.

Village of Little Chute: There were no significant issues within the Village during April.

There are 3 reminder letters to send and 2 site visits are required.

City of Kaukauna: A new restaurant (Orange Chicken Hut) has opened and will be introduced to the FOG Program as soon as we can arrange a site visit. We were unsuccessful in contacting the owner of Benchwarmers in regards to their initial trap cleaning. He generally works the late shift and will most likely require a late night phone call or visit.

Eight reminder letters will be sent and 3 site visits are required.
