HOVMSD FOG Control Program Update January 2018

Overview by Community

Darboy Sanitary District: During the month, we visited four restaurants, which are part of larger restaurant chains, in order to explain the FOG Control Program to new managers. In every case, the grease traps are being cleaned but the documentation is not being submitted.

A total of 5 reminder letters are required and 3 site visits will be conducted.

Village of Combined Locks: There were no significant issues within the Village in January.

No reminder letters are required and no site visits are necessary.

Village of Kimberly: There were no significant issues within the Village during January.

There are 3 reminder letters to send and one site visit will be required.

Village of Little Chute: Over the course of the month we talked to 5 business owners or managers regarding the timely cleaning of their grease traps and document submittal. Bel Brands is the only facility in which we could not verify that their traps were cleaned. Our email contact has not responded, so a site visit will be conducted.

There are no reminder letters to send and 1 site visits is required.

City of Kaukauna: The owner of Plan B appeared at the January HOVMSD Commission meeting to ask for reconsideration of the order to install a grease trap. The Commission discussed his request and determined that the facility would require a grease trap under the guidelines of the FOG Control Program.

A total of 6 reminder letters are required and 2 site visits will be performed.
