HOVMSD FOG Control Program Update February 2018

Overview by Community

Darboy Sanitary District: The new manager at the Stoneyard has been slow to respond to our request for their trap cleaning information. A physical check of the trap shows it is being cleaned but we are not receiving the paperwork. We will continue to meet with her each month until the issue is resolved.

A total of 5 reminder letters are required and 4 site visits will be conducted.

Village of Combined Locks: There were no significant issues within the Village in February.

Two reminder letters are required and no site visits are necessary.

Village of Kimberly: We met with the owner of Chefo's Restaurant and he asked to move his cleanings to every two months. We agreed to move them to every two months as they are on a limited serving schedule and a two month cleaning is in line with similar restaurants.

There are 2 reminder letters to send and one site visit will be required.

Village of Little Chute: There were no significant issues within the Village in February.

A total of 4 reminder letters will be sent and no visits are required.

City of Kaukauna: Plan B is on schedule to complete their trap installation in March. We will check in with them early in the month to make sure there are no issues.

Rico's Family Restaurant opened a restaurant on Wisconsin Avenue. We sent them an introduction letter and asked for an appointment to review the FOG Program with them. We will follow up with them during March.

We have been in discussions with the owner of the Subway Restaurant in regards to the frequency of their trap cleanings. They are going to clean the trap after 6 months and send us photographs of the interior of the trap, prior to cleaning. Based upon what they find, we will make a determination as to whether to move to six months or retain their current three month schedule.

A total of 2 reminder letters are required and 4 site visits will be performed.
