HOVMSD FOG Control Program Update June 2018

Overview by Community

Darboy Sanitary District: Most of the issues with past due cleanings were related to new management at the various restaurants. Those issues seemed to carry over into July, with the need for a large number of site visits to be scheduled.

A total of 2 reminder letters are required and 9 site visits will be conducted.

Village of Combined Locks: We inspected Rico's Family Restaurant with a plumber from JT Schmidt Plumbing and did not find any abnormalities in the faculty's piping that would explain the lack of grease collected in their trap. We will have to monitor the site over an extended period of time to determine if grease is washing through the trap and settling downstream.

One reminder letter is required and one site visit is necessary.

Village of Kimberly: Problems with non-compliance ranged from new management to ignoring our reminder letters. The Village did check the manhole downstream of Little Caesars and China Gate and no grease was noted. The Infinity Bar has closed.

There are 3 reminder letters to send 1 site visit will be required.

Village of Little Chute: We finally met with the owner of Shelley's Supper Club and she indicated that health problems kept her from scheduling her cleaning. She is now back on her feet and will schedule the cleaning shortly.

A total of 5 reminder letters will be sent and 2 site visits are required.

City of Kaukauna: We met with Rico, the owner of Electric City Lanes and he will be cleaning the trap on the same schedule as the nearby Rico's Family Restaurant.

A total of 5 reminder letters are required and 1 site visit will be performed.
