## HOVMSD FOG Control Program Update August 2018

### Overview

At the beginning of August, Speedy Clean found themselves about a month behind in servicing their grease trap customers within the Metropolitan Sewerage District. By the end of August, they were back on schedule.

### Overview by Community

**Darboy Sanitary District:** Ban Vinai cleaned their grease trap in August, under protest that they aren't open enough to produce so much grease. We encouraged the restaurant manager to check the trap himself and the cleaning was scheduled and performed shortly thereafter. To date, we have not received their documentation but will continue to monitor the trap each month. The remainder of the issues within the Sanitary District involved new managers or managers that needed a refresher on the purpose and rules of the FOG Control program.

A total of 6 reminder letters are required and 2 site visits will be conducted.

**Village of Combined Locks:** We met with the owner of Milltown Still and Grill and discussed their issues with adhering to their three month cleaning schedule. He agreed to clean his trap over the Labor Day weekend and said he would try to do a better job of maintaining his three month cleaning schedule.

One reminder letter is required and one site visit may be necessary.

**Village of Kimberly:** We stopped by Mr. Taco to talk to the owner about his non-compliance with the FOG Control Program. He was not available and, to date, has not called us back to schedule a meeting.

There are 6 reminder letters to send 1 site visit will be required.

**Village of Little Chute:** Both Bel Brands and the 5<sup>th</sup> Quarter have new management teams that had to be introduced to the FOG Control Program. Shelley Supper Club did not follow through on their promise to clean their trap and will require more oversight in September to get them back in compliance.

A total of 5 reminder letter will be sent and 1 site visit is required.

**City of Kaukauna:** Cozy Corner has closed but may conduct catering out of their facility. We will investigate this further in September.

A total of 3 reminder letters are required and 1 site visit will be performed.
