HOVMSD FOG Control Program Update

January 2019

Overview by Community

Darboy Sanitary District: The Ban Vanai restaurant will have a representative from Sanimax stop out to help us determine if the current six month cleaning schedule should be changed. We have noted very thick grease in their trap and ownership insists that this is acceptable with their having two traps running in series. The trap we inspect is assumed to be the second of the two, but we will try to confirm that with Sanimax.

A total of 2 reminder letters are required and 6 site visits will be conducted.

Village of Combined Locks: There were no significant issues related to the FOG Control Program for January, 2019.

No reminder letters are required and no site visits are necessary.

Village of Kimberly: Little Caesars is again non-compliant and uncooperative. We will pursue this more aggressively in February and try to set up a meeting with the business owner to reinforce the requirements and expectations of the FOG Control Program.

Three reminder letters are required and 2 site visits will need to be conducted.

Village of Little Chute: We talked to the contractor who cleans the Taco Bell traps and he indicated he was busy and would get there when he could free up some time. We informed him that this was unacceptable and he has not responded since. We visited the Taco Bell and informed them of their obligations under the FOG Program. We will follow-up with them as often as required to get them back in compliance.

No reminder letters are required and 1 site visit will be conducted.

City of Kaukauna: We are scheduling and conducting site visits at facilities that were recently constructed or recently opened and working with a cleaning contractor to verify the installation of grease traps at the High School concession areas. Electric City Lanes had promised to be in compliance by early January and has not done so. We will follow-up with management to determine why and what can be done to change that.

A total of 2 reminder letters are required and 5 site visits will be conducted.

HOVMSD: In January, we began working with Commissioner Siebers on a summary report of the FOG Control Program.

City of Kaukauna Grease Trap Inspections Summary Report January 31, 2019

Summary of Site Visits & Correspondence:

City of Kaukauna Fire Dept: We were informed that the new Fire station kitchen was constructed with a grease trap. On January 29, 2019, we stopped in the new Fire Department building and explained the FOG Control Program. At this point they will be assigned an annual cleaning schedule.

City of Kaukauna Community Center: We were informed that the new Community Center would have a grease trap installed in the kitchen area. On January 29, 2019, we stopped by City Hall and were informed that the new Center was still under construction. We will keep an eye on the progress and stop in when the building is completed.

313 Dodge and Little Food Company: On January 29, 2019, we stopped by the Little Food Company and 313 Dodge Street, during normal business hours and both were closed. This may have been due to subzero temperatures that day. We will send both parties an introduction letter with a request to set up an appointment for a site visit.

Electric City Lanes: On January 2, 2019, we met with Troy at Electric City Lanes and he indicated the trap cleaning would be done in January. To date, no documents have been received although the facility shares ownership with the nearby Rico's Family restaurant, which is now due for cleaning. We will talk to the management at Rico's to confirm that both sites are done in February.

Kaukauna High School Concessions: Kuettels contacted us regarding an information request they received, regarding cleaning the grease traps in the concession stands at Kaukauna High School. We were unaware that they existed and have asked Kuettels to provide us with the sizing and placement of those traps. Once they are confirmed, we will contact the High School maintenance department and get them added to the database.

Summary of Correspondence and Site Visits

Uno's, Red Robin, Walmart, Stoneyard, Little Chicago, Walmart, China Garden, Mac's/Pizza Ranch, Kimberly High School, Thai Sushi and Novo Grande: On January 22, 2019, the grease traps or downstream manholes for all of the above named locations were checked. All the traps or manholes were in good condition.

Ban Vinai: On January 22, 2019, we checked the trap at Ban Vinai and found the trap was still in need of cleaning. We talked to the site manager on January 31, 2019 and he indicated that this was only the 5th month of his 6 month schedule, but he would have Sanimax come in and check the trap the first week of February.

China Garden: On January 14, 2019 we talked to the manager of China Garden about their refusal to meet with us back in December, to talk about their non-compliance. She said it was all a misunderstanding and that the trap had been cleaned prior to our December visit. We received confirmation from Speedy Clean that the trap had actually been cleaned in January, 2019, soon after we sent them a letter inviting them to the January Darboy Commission Meeting.

Little Chicago: On January 31, 2019, we stopped at Little Chicago to speak with management about their past due cleaning. The restaurant owner had died and his partner was not on-site. The manager indicated that the partner was overwhelmed with trying to run the restaurant and would pass on our request for a meeting.

Village of Little Chute Grease Trap Inspections Summary Report January 31, 2019

Summary of Site Visits & Correspondence

Taco Bell: Early in January, we talked to the cleaning contractor for the Taco Bell facility. The cleaning contractor told us that he was busy and would hire someone local when he had time. We sent him an email indicating that the FOG Control Program was established to promote the timely cleaning of discharger's grease traps and a contractor being too busy to help the discharger meet that schedule, was not an acceptable excuse.

Hearing nothing back from the contractor, we visited the store on January 29, 2019 and talked to the store manager. She was unaware that they had a grease trap. We explained that they did and reviewed the requirements of the FOG Control Program with her. We also told her time was of the essence, as her contractor may or may not come to do the cleaning. The manager said she would look into it and get back to us. We will revisit the site in early February to get a status update.
