Operations Update

<u>Plant Operations</u> – Plant operations and treatment were for the most part good during the month of May. However, the plant had high flows on May 17th and 18th. There was no blending during this event but final effluent solids were high. This event caused the plant to use water quality trading credits. On May 28th the plant again had high flows due to rain. There was a blending event during this rainfall but treatment remained stable and no water quality trading credits were needed for the weekly average.

The water quality trading (TSS lbs/yr) credits that HOV has for 2020 is 2756. The calculated credits needed for the week of the 17th was 5705. This single event depletes all of the District's TSS credits for 2020.

<u>Bio-Solids Hauling</u> – United Liquid Waste has hauled out 1.6 million gallons of biosolids.

Maintenance Update

<u>PLC Upgrades at Meter Stations</u> – As soon as LW Allen receives all the parts needed to do the upgrade they will be scheduling to come in.

<u>Biostyr Blower</u> – The blower's projected delivery is the beginning of July.

<u>Final Effluent Reuse Pump</u> – The new reuse pump has been ordered.

<u>HOV Agricultural Land (Grass Buffers)</u> – No update.
