HOVMSD FOG Control Program Update

December 2020

Overview by Community

Darboy Sanitary District: Little Chicago is closed and in the process of being sold. The current owner has been given a notice of non-compliance and will have to disclose this to any potential buyers. Should the facility re-open before getting back into compliance, we will have to look into options to pursue an enforcement action. A total of 5 reminder letters are required and 4 site visits will be conducted.

Village of Combined Locks: There were no significant issues, related to the FOG Control Program, in December. No reminder letters are required and no site visits will need to be conducted.

Village of Kimberly: Savor and Mr. Taco have changed ownership and continue to be chronically non-compliant. At the time of our site visit, the manager at Savor gave little detail as to who purchased the two restaurants. We will have to do some research to identify and try to arrange a meeting with the new owner. A total of 2 reminder letters is required and 3 site visits will be conducted.

Village of Little Chute: The Subway store has again made the non-compliance list. We spoke with the new manager about the FOG Control Program and will await a positive response. A total of 1 reminder letters is required and 3 site visits will be conducted.

City of Kaukauna: We continue to monitor the former Quenchers site, The Mariner and Heirloom Kitchen Co. for signs of activity. At this point, none of them appear to be in operation. A total of 10 reminder letters are required and 6 site visits will be conducted.

Summary of Site Visits & Correspondence

Benchwarmers: On December 17, 2020, we stopped in at Benchwarmers and talked to the cleaning person about their last grease trap cleaning. After reviewing the maintenance calendar for the restaurant, he determined that the trap was last cleaned on November 15, 2020.

Quenchers: On December 17, 2020, we drove by the site and noted that the site is still not occupied. We will monitor the progress and arrange a site visit when the facility is ready to open.

Heirloom Kitchen Co.: On December 17, 2020, we stopped by Heirloom Kitchen Co. and they were closed. We will check with their cleaning contractor to determine if their grease trap has been service recently.

The Mariner: On December 17, 2020, we stopped at the Mariner during their advertised business hours and found they were closed.

Summary of Site Visits & Correspondence

Uno's, Red Robin, Stoneyard, Little Chicago, China Garden, Mac's/Pizza Ranch, Thai Sushi, Ban Vinai, Walmart and Novo Grande: On or around December 4, 2020, the grease traps or downstream manholes for all of the above-named locations were checked. All of the grease traps or manholes were in good condition.

Little Chicago: Several times in December, we visited Little Chicago during normal business hours and found it was closed. It is our understanding that the business has been sold, although no information on future operations is known. We did send a follow-up letter to the selling party to remind them that the facility is Non-Compliant with the HOVMSD FOG Control Program, which would have to be disclosed to any buyers. At this time, we will assume the sale will go through and when it does, we will make contact with the new owners to get the trap cleaned and the facility back into compliance.

Agropur: On December 4, 2020 we visited Agropur to discuss the submittal of their grease trap cleaning documents. The kitchen manager looked up the last invoice and provided us with the proper documents.

Pizza Ranch: On December 4, 2020, we talked to the owner of Pizza Ranch and he provided us with the latest cleaning documentation. While the documents were more recent than our records, he still was past due on his two-month cleaning schedule. We sent him another reminder and never heard back from him.

Subway: On December 18, 2020, we met with the store manager at Subway. She was new to the site and was unaware of what a grease trap was or that it should be cleaned. We left our information and asked that the owner call us. To date, we have not heard back.

Marcus Theaters: Due to a very inconsistent operating schedule and significant reduction in movie attendance, we have put any actions regarding Marcus Theaters on hold. We will evaluate their business each month and when they return to a semblance of normalcy, we will work with them to ensure the traps are cleaned.
