# HOVMSD Website Observations / Recommendations July 2021

Overall, the HOVMSD website is outdated by today's standards. While there is quite a bit of information available on the website, it is not user friendly or visually interesting.

Observations / recommendations about current website pages:

### Home page

- A more user-friendly design is needed.
- Add information about the important role that HOVMD plays for the member communities and the environment
- Include map of district and important features

#### Personnel

- Commission
  - o Include brief commission bios/profiles with a photo of each commissioner
- Plant
  - o Include photo(s) of plant staff
- Staff
  - o Include leadership bios/profiles with a photo of each leadership team member

#### Meetings

• A design update is needed, including brief description of role of the commission

#### About us

- Include more than just the Mission Statement
- Add an explanation of the organization structure, member communities, etc...
- A virtual tour is recommended with video (including drone video) showing the plant operations

# **Public information**

- Administrative
  - o Move to Reports tab with brief description of report categories
- Articles
  - o Include a brief description of the articles along with the links to the PDFs
- Budget
  - o Explanation of role of HOVMSD, how budget is developed, what the flow rate means for member communities and end users (homeowners / businesses)
  - Include information on billing process

- Community Links
  - o OK with design update
- CMAR Data by Community
  - Move to Reports tab and explain significance and state requirements for Compliance Maintenance Annual Reports
- Plant
  - Move information to Reports tab and add brief description of reports
- Reports
  - o Including and explain all reporter here

## Master Planning & Reports

- Recommend moving much of this information to a new Projects Tab (move report links to separate reports tab see above)
  - o Include information about current projects and recently completed projects
  - Current project information should be updated regularly when new information is available

## **Job Openings**

 Some explanation of application process should be added, even if there are no current job openings

#### Additional website recommendations:

- Need clear listing with Contact Information
- Page with information for end users (homeowners/businesses)
  - o Toilets are not garbage cans what not to flush
    - Cooking grease, non-biodegradable items, cotton balls, Q-tips, diapers, wipes, feminine products, rags, paper towels, dental floss, medication, cat litter, gum, food, bleach
    - The WWTF is designed to only handle human waste and toilet tissue
- Environmental programs page
  - o Describe HOVMSD's important role in environmental protection
  - o Provide information about efforts important to the environment
    - Mercury reduction program
    - Pre-treatment program
    - Biosolids
- Media page
  - o Include media coverage, news releases, contact information
- Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)
  - o Potential questions should include:

- Is HOVMSD part of the city of Kaukauna government or the surrounding village governments?
- Do you send utility bills to homeowners?
- How much wastewater does HOVMSD handle in an average day?
- Where does the wastewater come from?
- How is it transported to the WWTF?
- Where does the water go after it's treated?
- How clean is the treated water?
- How much does it cost to treat the wastewater?

## Website options

Option 1 – website re-design

L&F will seek bids from at least two website developers and work cooperatively with the selected vendor on a new design and updated copy for the website.

Option 2 – updates to existing website

L&F will update and draft additional copy and visuals to improve the existing HOVMSD website. L&F will need access to the website to determine the extent of updating that can be accomplished.
