Darboy Sanitary District: Periodic checks of the exterior traps were conducted at sites or mini-malls where the cleanings are normally done on schedule, but the documentation is lost at corporate. Seven reminder letters are required and one site visit will need to be conducted.

Village of Combined Locks: There were no significant issues, related to the FOG Control Program, in July. One reminder letter is required and no site visits will be conducted.

Village of Kimberly: Mom and Pop's Bakery has closed due to the owner's retirement. The facility is currently being remodeled and may re-open as a bakery again. Three reminder letters are required and one site visit will need to be conducted`.

Village of Little Chute: Throughout several communities, the Starbucks Stores have been uniformly unresponsive to our request to verify they are cleaning their traps. The Little Chute site is no exception. Fortunately, the sites all have exterior traps and can still be monitored. Two reminder letters are required and one site visit will need to be conducted.

City of Kaukauna: 3 Brothers Restaurant has opened in the site formerly occupied by Rico's, Chico's, La Patrona and Mena's. Seven reminder letters are required, five site visits will need to be conducted and one site is in the process of installing a grease trap. .

Summary of Site Visits & Correspondence

Red Robin, SALT, China Garden, Mac's/Pizza Ranch, Thai Sushi, Ban Vinai, Tulum, Walmart and Novo Grande: On or around July 9, 2024, the grease traps or downstream manholes for all of the above-named locations were checked. All of the grease traps or manholes were in good condition.

Over the course of the month, we checked the exterior traps at the following locations and/or mini-malls in which multiple dischargers are located. Most of these sites are dischargers in which we have difficulty getting their documents submitted. This helps us to verify that the businesses are still cleaning their traps while we work on developing contacts to also get the verification docuantation submitted.
