Darboy Sanitary District: A majority of the sites requiring site visits were serviced by Sanimax and the issue with non-compliance was a reporting issue and not a cleaning one. Short of Sanimax having a change of heart regarding their privacy policy, there is not much we can do, but visit the site and confirm the cleanings. Three reminder letters are required and three site visits will need to be conducted.

Village of Combined Locks: There were no significant issues, related to the FOG Control Program, in October. No reminder letters are required and no site visits will be conducted.

Village of Kimberly: Goly and Eves replaced their old cast iron trap with a new on, in October. Their site is now home to an ice cream parlor and they do occasional catering. The Puerta Rican restaurant has closed. Two sites will require reminder letters and one site visit will need to be conducted.

Village of Little Chute: The original El Jaripeo on Main Street has been closed for some time and the condition of the building would indicate it will not reopen without significant renovation. Seven reminder letters are required and one site visit will need to be conducted.

City of Kaukauna: The GrandStay Hotel and the Taco Bell are now open. Both were introduced to the FOG Control Program, in October. The former Cake Anatomy site will soon be a retail shop. Three reminder letters are required and three site visits will need to be conducted.
