

Old and New Business 7-14-26

- **Storm event recap 7/2** – District service area was hit with storms and heavy rains on 7/1 into 7/2. The area received 2 inches of rain with locally higher amounts in the Valley. The operator on call was summoned for the event but the influent flows did not exceed 23-24 MGD at its peak and no blending event occurred. The outcome likely would have been different had we not had dry weather in advance of the storms.
- **PFAS Update** – The District collected and is analyzing a second biosolids sample to get additional data versus relying on one single sample point. DNR has recently released updated guidance documents that include considerations of Wisconsin Act 201 passed 4/6/26. This action reduced the PFOS+PFOA numerical tiers and reduces the ceiling biosolids land application from 150 to 100 ug/kg for land application

HOV has also taken its permit required effluent sample for July/Aug and sent it for analysis. Its result will be our 4th sample result from the 12 required in the first two years of the new permit.

- **Headworks/Screening Project** – Various Donohue engineers will be on site 7/14/26 to take photos, field measurements and review the project documents against existing conditions. Project financing was resolved last month and DNR notified we are not taking a loan. We have a couple specific insurance questions that remain for bidding documents and whatever comes up from the onsite visit. No word from DNR yet on acceptance of the facility plans that were submitted.
